Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Sealing:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act (5 U.S.C. 552).

On or about May 16th, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued a notice of enforcement action to GE-Hitachi Global Laser Enrichment (GLE) regarding the facility in Wilmington, North Carolina. I am requesting a copy of that notice.

In order to help you determine my status for the purpose of assessing fees, you should know that I am affiliated with the American Physical Society (APS), an educational and noncommercial scientific organization. The APS occasionally comments on physics-related issues of concern to our membership, including civilian nuclear energy, nuclear weapons and nonproliferation. This request is made for furthering the educational and scientific purposes of APS and not for any commercial use.

The APS currently has a petition pending before the NRC – that petition was motivated in part by the GLE facility in Wilmington and was shaped by the proliferation assessment carried out by GLE. The document I am requesting will inform our decisions on whether or how to proceed with the petition.
