This letter is in response to your April 4, 2010, letter that requested the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) initiate a mandatory declassification review of a February 1978 report entitled, "*Inquiry into the Testimony of the Executive Director for Operations*", Volumes I, II, and III. We provided you a status of the review on July 29, 2010.

As noted in the July 2010 response, the NRC has checked its historical records and determined that the report exists in a publicly available version. The NRC also performed a page-by-page comparison of the classified version of the report against the publicly available version. The review found instances in Volumes I and III where classified portions were removed or redacted prior to the publicly available versions being released.

Additionally, the NRC has coordinated the review of the remaining classified portions in Volumes I and III with other United States government agencies that have equities in the subject matter. The NRC has received a response from these other agencies regarding the remaining classified portions and their recommendation for retention or release of the information. The other agencies have requested the classified portions remain classified. The NRC concurs with the decision to keep these portions classified as they contain protected source information.
