Waiver_ExtentToExtractAnalyze: Information in the records will be correlated with the oil and gas well database maintained by the Kentucky Geological Survey and be made a part of those records.

Waiver_SpecificActivityQuals: The information will be used for subsurface research and well locations review for permitting oil and gas wells in the state of Kentucky. The Kentucky Geological Survey reviews all oil and gas well permits in the state of Kentucky and acts as the public repository for oil and gas records.

Waiver_ImpactPublicUnderstanding: At this time the public is unaware of these records unless happened upon by chance. Event records are only available at this time if the well operator disclosed this information in the well history.

Waiver_NatureOfPublic: All users of the Kentucky Geological Survey's online oil and gas well information database. There were 223,120 public searches of the oil and gas and coal databases during FY 2009-2010, with over 1.2 million records downloaded.
