(EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY) DATED DECEMBER 30, 2004

Dear Mr. Roudebush:

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated June 7, 2011, regarding the Order Prohibiting Involvement in U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Licensed Activities (Effective Immediately) (Order), dated December 30, 2004.

In your letter, you provided information regarding a verbal, tentative employment offer from an Agreement State licensee that could consist of or develop into a position involving NRC-licensed activities. Although we appreciate your notification, we have determined that it does not meet the terms of the Order. In accordance with the Order, you are required to provide notification, within 20 days of accepting your first employment offer involving NRC licensed activities or becoming involved in NRC-licensed activities. The notification must include a statement of your commitment to compliance with regulatory requirements and the basis why the Commission should have confidence that you will now comply with applicable NRC requirements.
