This proceeding involves a license amendment request by Florida Power & Light Company to increase, from 2,700 megawatts thermal to 3,020 megawatts thermal, the licensed core power level for St. Lucie Plant, Unit 1, which is located in St. Lucie County, Florida. In response to a "Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment to Facility Operating License, and Opportunity for a Hearing" published in the Federal Register on June 9, 2011 (76 Fed. Reg. 33,789), a hearing request was submitted by Thomas Saporito on behalf of Saproani Associates.
