In Reference 1, PSEG submitted an application for an Early Site Permit for the PSEG Site. Reference 2 transmitted the Offsite Radiological Emergency Response Plans (RERP) for the States of Delaware, New Jersey, and Maryland and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in support of the Early Site Permit (ESP) application.

The RERPs for the States of Delaware and New Jersey were recently revised to correct some minor typographical errors and to incorporate comments received during the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) review of the RERPs in support of the PSEG ESP application. PSEG hereby transmits the revised RERPs for the States of Delaware and New Jersey in support of the PSEG ESP application. The enclosed radiological emergency response plans are designated as "Security-Related Information – Withhold Under 10CFR2.390," as requested by the NRC. Enclosure 1 is an affidavit requesting that this Sensitive Information be held in confidence by the NRC and exempt from public disclosure pursuant to the policy reflected in NRC letter from William Reckley to Russell Bell (NEI) dated February 10, 2009. Enclosures 2 and 3 are the revised RERPs for the States of Delaware and New Jersey, respectively.

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A hard copy of Enclosures 2 and 3 is being provided to the Document Control Desk because some of the figures in the enclosures will not pass the electronic pre-flight requirements. 


