In your letter dated July 20, 2011 (ADAMS Accession No. ML112270153) you asked for a license address changed, but you did not indicate if the Fort Monmouth, NJ location listed in License Condition 10 should be removed. If you would like the NJ location to be removed we will need leak tests and surveys to indicate that there is no residual contamination.

Based on this phone call, Mr. Silber indicated that he is working with Betsy Ullrich, Branch 2 on their NRC License No. 29-01022-06. They have agreed to retain the Fort Monmouth location on their license and will remove it when all the radioactive material has been removed from that location. Currently, Mr. Silber indicated that they possess no RAM under their -14 license at Fort Monmouth. But for consistency, we will keep Fort Monmouth on the license and remove it later – to make sure that there is no residual contamination at the facility.
