Betsy:

This refers to your 12 August 2011 Email below and to our telephone conversation, this date.

We will require a new Radioactive Material License number with the Maryland prefix 19-xxxxx-xx, but we will still require the Fort Monmouth location to be recognized as an authorized place of use until such time as all licensed radioactive material is removed from this installation, which is expected within the next few months. We therefore will require the condition of use

to read "Licensed material may be used or stored at the licensee's facilities located at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland, Fort Monmouth, New Jersey and at the Department of Defense installations anywhere in the United States and at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States."

Once the new license with the Maryland prefix is issued, termination of NRC License Number 29-01022-14 can be initiated.

We do not currently possess any radioactive material under this license that requires IC implementation.

This is about your letter requesting to change the 29-01022-14 mailing address from NJ to MD. I called your telephone line and got the voice mail message to send an email today.

1. This will require us to issue a new license number using the Maryland prefix 19-xxxxx-xx and to terminate the 29-01022-14 license. Are you ready to do this? See next two items before answering this.

2. What do you want done with the location of use address? At the

moment,
it states "Licensed material may be used or stored at the licensee's facilities located at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey and at the Department of Defense installations anywhere in the United States and at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States." Do you want both the Fort Monmouth and APG addresses as locations of use and storage? Did you already move everything to APG (under the ".DoD installations anywhere." clause) so that the -14 license can be terminated?

3. related to item 2, above, you have items that require IC implantation; I think we are supposed to review this before we allow you to move the items, as we did with the -06 license, yes???
