By e-mail dated August 15, 2011, Uranium One requested NRC approval to submit the Willow Creek ISR Project Semi-Annual Report and revised annual surety estimate on or before September 18, 2011. The reasons for the request are stated in Uranium One's e-mail to NRC. Under SUA-1341, license condition 9.5, the annual surety estimate is required to be submitted to NRC by August 18 of each year. Semi-annual effluent monitoring reporting under 10 CFR 40.65, referenced in license condition 12.1, is due August 30 of each year. Your request for extension to submit the Semi-Annual Report and annual surety estimate on or before September 18, 2011 is approved. Please contact me if you have any questions.

Ron as we discussed earlier today, in July Uranium One made a request to the WDEQ-LQD, District III office, to extend the deadline for the WDEQ annual report for Permit to Mine No. 478 (Willow Creek SUA – 1341) from August 18, 2011 to September 18, 2011. Attached is the approval letter from the WDEQ-LQD for that request. As per SUA-1341 License Condition 9.5 a revised surety estimate shall be provided to the NRC each year on August 18th. The annual report for the WDEQ-LQD that Uranium One is preparing will also be submitted to the NRC. This report serves as the NRC semiannual 10 CFR Part 40.65 effluent report for SUA-1341. Historically, as part of this report Uranium One will incorporate a text description of the changes that were made to the surety estimate from the previous year's estimate. This is a critical tool to the agencies in navigating and evaluating the various changes made to the surety spreadsheet. License Condition 12.1 does not specifically identify a date for the 40.65 effluent report, but the surety estimate revision does have a specific date (License Condition 9.5). As the report and surety estimate have historically be submitted as one document, Uranium One would like to maintain this submittal as one document. If the documents are submitted at different times, the reviewers will not have the benefit of the discussion presented in the report including: Section 3, a description of mining activities; Section 4, surface reclamation and groundwater restoration activities; Section 5, future mine planning; Section 6, reclamation and restoration planning, Section 7, monitoring activities for the year and Section 8, the descriptions of changes to the reclamation performance surety estimate discussed above. Although 10 CFR Part 40, Criteria 9 does not specifically call out the submittal of a detailed description of the changes made to the surety every year, Uranium One has provided the descriptions in the report for the benefit of the agency reviewers. We request of the NRC that Uranium One be allowed to submit the Semi Annual report with the revised annual surety estimate and corresponding text description to the NRC at the same time we submit the report (same report) to the WDEQ-LQD on or before September 18, 2011. Your immediate attention to this would be greatly appreciated.


