Dear Dr. Bocchini:

Due to a change in the NRC's licensing policies, total possession limits for regulated nuclear materials need to be listed on NRC licenses, if applicable. As discussed between Wally Fuhrman and Frank Tran by telephone on May 9, 2011, and based on the information he provided, we have listed the total possession limit for Item 6.E on your license.

Enclosed is a corrected copy to your NRC license as a result of this change in the licensing policy. If you have any question regarding this change, please contact the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office immediately at (630) 829-9839.

Please note, we have removed the increased controls license conditions from your license because your total possession limit is under the threshold screening value that requires these license conditions.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005- 31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system. Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
