Enclosed is Amendment No.16 renewing your NRC Material License No.48-18916-02 in accordance with your request.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note in Item No. 9 of your NRC Materials License we changed the name of the manufacturer for your gauge that you posses. This modification was necessary so that the name of the manufacturer listed on your license is the same as the name listed in the Sealed Source and Device Registry.

We also updated you license by modifying License Condition No. 13. D and by adding License Condition No. 13. F. These changes enhance your awareness of the radiation safety program elements in your license and our regulatory requirements.

Lastly, we excluded the request to store materials in locations listed in Item No. 3 of your application dated January 28, 2011. The NRC cannot authorize storage of materials in Agreement State locations.


In accordance with 10 Code of Federal Regulations 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.
