This refers to an investigation completed by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Office of Investigations (OI) on May 26, 2011, regarding the action of an employee at North Anna Power Station in Mineral, Virginia. The purpose of the OI investigation was to determine whether the employee willfully provided inaccurate information on an Owner Controlled Area Random Vehicle Search form. The enclosure to this letter provides the synopsis of the investigation.

Based on the review of the circumstances and the OI investigation, the NRC concluded that North Anna Power Station's actions in this regard did not represent a violation of regulatory requirements. In addition, North Anna Power Station's actions after becoming aware of the individual providing inaccurate information were appropriate. Accordingly, we plan no further action with regard to this matter. Should you have any questions, please contact us.
