Hello Michele,

Attached please find a copy of Special Permit 14657, Revision 3, renewed by DOT through 31 August 2012. I am also attaching the two letters we sent DOT in regards to this matter, along with a copy of the original letter to NRC. Please note I sent two letters as the first letter to DOT did not cover all the questions required under the regs that took effect earlier this year.

I had requested DOT give MURR a three year extension to the special permit, the same as I requested in my letter to NRC. DOT instead has issued a one year extension, so I would like to formally ask that our request for a three year authorization from NRC be reduced to a one-year authorization to coincide with our DOT special permit.

Also, please note that I have requested that we be allowed to make up to 1500 total shipments under NRC authorization, up from 1000, due to the slower than expected efforts of our vendor to provide replacement packaging.

If the information attached does not meet all your needs, please do not hesitate to contact me and I will make sure we provide all necessary follow-up that will allow for a re-authorization by NRC to continue shipping under SP 14657.
