If FPL was unable to provide a response within 45 days, NRC requested FPL to provide a schedule to provide the responses. In its Reference 2 letter, FPL informed the NRC that the response to RAI 9.3-4, 9.3-6, 9.3-8, and 9.3-15 through 9.3-17 would be provided by August 17, 2011 and response to RAI 9.3-3 and 9.3-9 through 9.3-14 would be provided by August 22, 2011. This letter provides the revised response schedule for these RAIs.

The response to RAI 9.3-3, 9.3-4, 9.3-6, and 9.3-8 through 9.3-17 will be provided by September 13, 2011.
