Enclosed is Amendment No.03 renewing your NRC Material License No.12-32308-01 in accordance with your request.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

**Please note in Item Nos. 7 and 9 of your NRC Materials License we changed the name of the manufacturer for the gauges that you possess. This modification was necessary so that the name of the manufacturer listed on your license is the same as the name listed in the Sealed Source and Device Registry.**

**We also updated your license by adding License Condition No. 13. F. This change requires that you to retain leak test records for a period of three years.**

**In addition, we excluded the request to store materials at 803 West State Street, O' Fallon, Illinois, location as requested in Item No. 3 of your application dated January 5, 2011. The NRC cannot authorize storage of materials in Agreement State locations on the licenses we issue.**

**We also excluded the request to self- appoint Radiation Safety Officers (RSOs) and we removed Condition No. 11. B as it appeared on Amendment No. 02 in your NRC Material License. Due to an NRC policy change, you will not be able to change and name your RSO internally as Condition No. 11. B previously allowed. NRC must do that for you via the amendment process.**

**For future RSO changes please submit the name of the proposed RSO; his/her training and experience qualifications; a statement signed and dated by the proposed RSO that s/he accepts the position as RSO and that s/he understands the duties and responsibilities associated with the RSO position.**



Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
