Re: Request for License Amendment for U.S. Environmental Protection Agency-National Enforcement Investigations Center (EPA-NEIC) – NRC License No. 05-14892-01

Dear Ms. Cook:

This letter serves to notify NRC that there have been some changes in the source/material use and conditions of our license and therefore we request that our NRC Material License No. 05-14892-01 be amended to reflect these changes.

It is my understanding that the five electron capture detectors containing Nickel-63 sources in our three gas chromatographs that are referenced in 6.B. and 9.B. of our license are only subject to the general license requirements under 10 CFR 31.5. These sources have been registered with NRC by the instrument manufacturer and specific license holder, Agilent Technologies, Inc. Therefore, it would appear that it is not necessary to include these sources on our specific material license and if this is correct, please delete these entries on our license. We will continue to comply with the general license requirements for these sources under 10 CFR 31.5.


Under condition number 11.A., please change the names of persons that may use or for those under the supervision to include: Steven A. Fletcher (myself), Richard C. Ross, and Benjamin A. Burns. I am our current RSO (condition number 11.C.), Mr. Ross is our former RSO, and Mr. Burns will most likely succeed me to become our RSO later this year upon my planned retirement (we will notify you when this becomes certain).

Also, I have discovered an error on our current license (amendment #23), i.e., condition numbers 10.B. and 11.B. are incorrect because they refer to portable XRF devices which we no longer possess and these conditions should have been removed when amendment #23 was issued. Please delete these entries on our license.

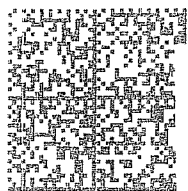
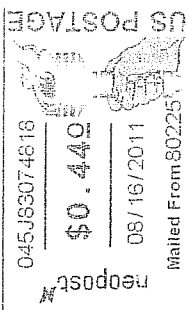
