The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is required to identify the Governor's designee to receive advance notification of transportation of certain shipments of nuclear waste and spent fuel through your State, pursuant to Section 301 of Public Law 96-295 and as implemented by Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Parts 71.97 and 73.37. The applicable portions of these regulations are enclosed.

We respectfully request that your office confirm that Mr. Gregory Talley, Program Manager, District of Columbia Department of Health, is the Mayor's official designee to receive such advance notification. We seek to confirm this designation in order to avoid having to list Mayor Gray as the individual to receive such notices. On several occasions we have tried to confirm Mr. Talley's official designation without success. Hence, we now request your assistance directly to confirm this designation.

As required, we will publish an updated list of Governors' designees, or the Mayor's name if such designee information is not confirmed by your office, in the *Federal Register*, in October 2011. We request confirmation of your designee within 30 days from the date of this letter.
