SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION (OI 4-2010-060)

Dear Mr. Dietrich:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC's Office of Investigations regarding activities at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station. The Office of Investigations initiated the investigation to determine whether a mechanical general foreman at San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station willfully failed to conduct a procedurally required walkdown or a review of a tagout boundary while working under a work control authorization.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation was not determined to be willful. The NRC plans no further action related to the willful aspects of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.
