Please find included in this correspondence an attached "Delegation of Authority" naming Craig Hendrickson as interim Radiation Safety Officer for the Menlo Park USGS NRC License 04-06674-07. Mr. Hendrickson is a temporary replacement for Paul Kovach who was recently named Radiation Safety Officer in Menlo Park, per our license amendment #56. Mr. Hendrickson is presently functioning as Radiation Safety Officer for the Denver USGS NRC license 05-01399-08 (docket number 030-03728) per license amendment #75.

Part 1 Section B, 2.2 of the Menlo Park Radiation Safety Manual states in part that "In the absence of the Chairperson, the duties will be performed by the acting Chairperson as provided by Part I, Section B, 3.5 of this manual" in which it is specified that "Throughout this manual all references to the Chairperson or the Secretary means either the sitting or acting officer in these capacities. Documents, minutes, and memoranda signed by an acting officer shall have the same import as those signed by the officer represented unless over-ruled by a Committee action"

Subject: Delegation of Authority for Radiation Safety Officer

On an interim basis, beginning 8/23/2011, Craig Hendrickson has agreed to perform the duties of Radiation Safety Officer for Menlo Park and is responsible for ensuring the safe use of byproduct material. The Radiation Safety Officer is responsible for managing the radiation safety program; identifying radiation safety problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; and ensuring compliance with regulations for the use of byproduct material. The Radiation Safety Officer is hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet these responsibilities.

The Radiation Safety Officer has the authority to immediately stop any operations involving the use of byproduct material in which health and safety may be compromised or may result in non-compliance with NRC requirements.

We have word from the NRC that amendment 56 has been approved.
