This letter is to confirm that the dress rehearsal and exercise in support of the Fort Calhoun Nuclear Station previously scheduled for September 20 and October 18, 2011, respectively, have been removed from FEMA's schedule. This action is taken in response to the agreed upon postponement of the 2011 plume exercise, dress rehearsal, and related activities in recognition of the impacts of severe flooding to the Utility and the Offsite Response Organizations.
