Thanks Doug. Looks good to me. I will probably follow the same format, and add the participants on the phone call for documentation purposes.

I will need to discuss w/you this week RES' current thoughts on which plants (even those that have previously declined) they still plan on pursuing for information on a non-voluntary basis. Susquehanna and Calvert Cliffs (Oconee and Grand Gulf are on that list). THIS IS STILL PRELIMIARY information, not to be discussed w/licensee's, and is being discussed at the RES senior management and EDO level. I will keep you posted.

That said, can you give me any high level licensing activities that are in house or projected within the next year that you, as Plant Project Manager, think will challenge the licensee's efforts (resources) to support the project? For example, Susquehanna currently has EPU and license renewal reviews in-house. John Lubinski asked to gather this insight from the respective plant PMs so that he can provide that feedback to RES.
