^b As we have already done for our Hawaii ranges, we plan to request, for the five installations numbered 2 through 6, that the NRC not enforce its requirement for a radiation safety program (RSP) approved by the NRC via a license due to the undue burden (hardship) that would be placed on the Army due to the consequent possible significant adverse impact on Army readiness, national defense, and security. We will use the pending NRC-approved RSP for Hawaii as a template for the RSPs of the other installations listed in this table when we send our requests. A license amendment request for each of remaining installations will follow as soon as possible in the order shown.

^c We plan to submit only a license amendment request for each of these installations in the order shown.
