SUMMARY

I contacted Marc to inform him that it was my view that most, if not all, of the procedures that he marked in both applications as confidential and to be protected in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, did not meet the criteria for protection.

He stated that all of the confidential and 2.390 markings were a mistake. The confidential and 2.390 statements appear in the header of all of Essential Isotopes document. Marc said that he forgot to remove from the documents that were included in the applications before he submitted the application.

He stated that neither of the applications contain confidential information and therefore do not need to be protected.

He agreed to draft a letter to clarify this information.
