Thank you for your voice message. Attached please find the March 31, 2011 letter that we sent to Mr. Griffin concerning the proposed license renewal for the Calvert Cliffs Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI). As stated in the letter, Calvert Cliffs is seeking to have the NRC license for the ISFSI renewed for a period of 40 years.
