2. Corrective Action

- A. The most significant change that AIX have made this past year has been to add a third person working independently of the two-man crew, whose responsibility is to develop the film and take care of the film interpretation and weld reports. This has allowed the two-man crew to focus on taking the radiographic exposures with no reason to leave the job site until all exposures are completed.
- B. Monthly safety meetings are now being held.
- C. Alaska Industrial X-ray, Inc. has Don Millar as our radiation safety officer.
- D. Alaska Industrial X-ray, Inc. has employed an unbiased third party to monitor the radiographers.
- E. Peter Millar, the President of Alaska Industrial X-ray, Inc. has begun a review of each radiographer and has taken an active interest in what is taking place at all times, day or night. This review is on a minimum of a quarterly basis.
- F. The Facility Manager continues to discuss radiation safety and the requirement that our ropes and signs are to be respected by all personnel at the facility. The facility Safety Manager is also cognizant of the radiation problems and the requirements for radiation safety.


3. Corrective Action to Avoid Further Violations

- A. Any radiographer shall be terminated from further employment if found violating the two man rule.
- B. Management will do its utmost to ensure the two qualified individuals are always present at the job site by:
 - a. Having a third person take responsibility for developing film,
 - b. Interpreting results and coordinating work.
 - c. Conducting surveillance of the two-man crew by an independent third party.
 - d. Conducting surveillance of the two man crew by management at a minimum of quarterly
 - e. Conducting surveillance by the RSO as required by the regulations.
 - f. Holding monthly safety meetings to discuss radiation safety.

4. I believe that I will be in compliance as of this date 8/2/2011 with all these requirements and have the understanding that if I do not that I shall be terminated.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
