In the renewal application, dated July 27, 2011, we specifically requested that Promethium-147 be removed from the distribution license. We have not produced or distributed any products containing Pm-147 since 2008-2009. Nor do we intend to re-introduce Pm-147.

In parallel with this renewal application, we are also amending our possession licenses to remove Pm-147. I have already made that request in the renewal application for the Mountaintop, PA facility. I will be filing amendment applications to make the same change to the Memphis, TN and the Ontario, CA facilities in the next few weeks.

Shirley,

We have performed additional research of our records and have more information related to the inclusion of our Salina, Kansas facility on the e-distribution license (29-20609-02E).

A State Possession and Use license was issued to the facility in 1991. As a result, my statement that a Possession and Use license was not obtained for this facility is obviously incorrect. It seems the Possession and Use license was issued as a supplementary amendment (#18) to the facility's existing Sealed Source license that I mentioned in my letter yesterday. This supplementary amendment included the byproduct materials listed on the e-distribution license (H-3, Kr-85, Pm-147). A copy of the license amendment is attached.

In addition, our archive records show the license was renewed, with the byproduct materials included, through ~1995. From that point on, we have no definitive records reflecting the inclusion of the byproduct materials on the State P&U license. At this point, I am unable to confirm, if, or when, the byproduct materials were removed from the State license.

Despite the confusion regarding the status of the State P&U license, the byproduct materials were never used at, stored at, or distributed from the Salina, KS facility and I re-emphasize the request in my letter of September 13, 2011 to remove it from the e-distribution license.
