I discussed with Dr. Graham that the current authorization on the license is above the allowable amount of unsealed materials for prescribed values and discussed his options. He decided that he would amend the license to remove his unsealed Ra-226 as he did not possess any. I stated that a new Certification of Financial Assurance (CFA) would be needed that reflected the removed Ra-226 value. I also suggest that he not list sealed items in the CFA as it was not needed. I then discussed needing documentation and leak tests of materials that were removed from the license. I told Dr. Graham that I would send him a letter, but needed to get how he wanted to conform to financial assurance requirements before sending a letter.
