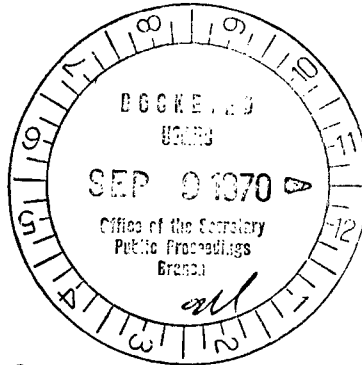

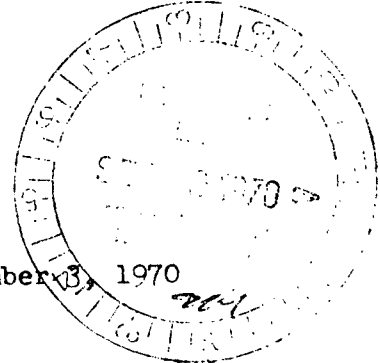

On September 1st, 1970, I directed a letter to you enclosing a resolution of the St. Paul City Council, Council File No. 250268, requesting the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board to deny the petition of Northern States Power Company for a provisional operating license for fuel loading and low-power start-up testing of its Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant, Unit No. 1.

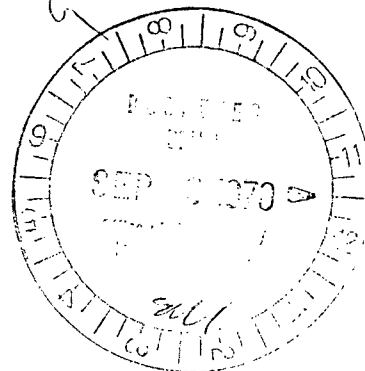

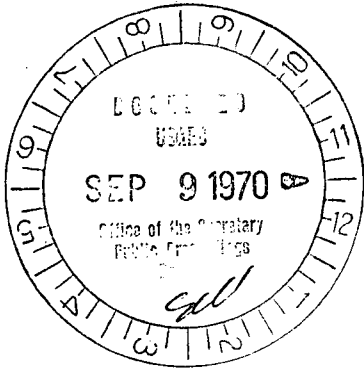

WHEREAS, The Board of Water Commissioners of the City of Saint Paul, at its meeting held on Monday, August 31, 1970, took action to request the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board to deny the petition of Northern States Power Company for a provisional operating license for fuel loading and low-power start-up testing of its Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant, Unit No. 1; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Council of the City of Saint Paul, on behalf of the City of Saint Paul, its citizens and consumers of the water supply supplied by its Water Department, does hereby concur in the actions taken by the Board of Water Commissioners of the City of Saint Paul, and does hereby respectfully request the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, United States Atomic Energy Commission, to deny the provisional operating license for fuel loading and low-power start-up testing of the Northern States Power Company's Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant, Unit No. 1;

The Council of the City of Saint Paul believes that this plant should not be allowed to operate unless and until Northern States Power Company makes provision for complete off-site disposal of all radioactive liquids, gaseous and solid wastes. The operation of this plant at this time under a provisional operating license would present a potentially hazardous threat to the health and safety of the people of the City of Saint Paul, the surrounding communities and to the integrity of the Saint Paul water supply; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Clerk is hereby directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to Valentine B. DeLoe, Chairman, Atomic Safety and Licensing Board, United States Atomic Energy Commission, Washington, D. C. 20545.
