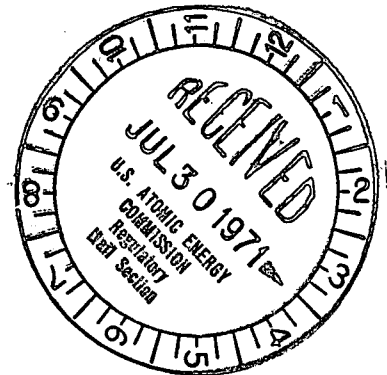

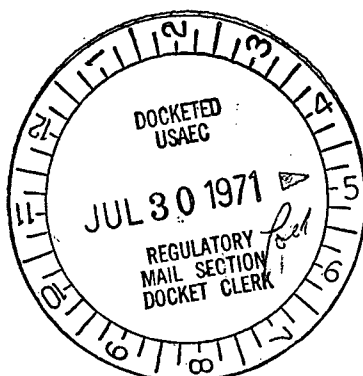
This is the third annual report and includes the results of background radiation monitoring and ecological studies in the area of the plant.
