## DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

TO: The Radiation Safety Officer


FROM: Barbara J. Larson

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority

You, Todd K. Bostwick, M.D., have been appointed Radiation Safety Officer and are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems, initiating, recommending or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with the rules. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of radioactive material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff does not cooperate and does not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to request amendment changes and raise issues with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time.
