Dear Mr. Wright:

Based upon evaluations performed during the Emergency Operating Procedure (EOP) Audit recently completed by the NRC, along with our own desire to provide an increased quantity of EOP training since implementation of the EOP flow charts has occurred, the following EOP-specific training is planned for all shifts during the next six weeks of regularly-scheduled training:

- Four hours of classroom training on the EOPs and the use of the EOP flow charts;
- 16 to 20 hours of simulator time specifically devoted to EOPs using the flow charts with emphasis on running the simulator scenarios to a depth of difficulty which demonstrates use of the EOPs beyond design basis accident conditions; and,
- An evaluation of crew performance during EOP simulator scenarios, which will be approximately 2 to 2-1/2 hours in length and will include critiques by both Training Center personnel and Operations management.

If the above simulator demonstrations indicate unsatisfactory operator performance, remedial training will be completed and satisfactory performance demonstrated prior to returning an individual to the normal on-shift rotation. Similarly, if individuals miss the above-specified EOP training which is scheduled to conclude on August 26, 1988, a personal evaluation will be completed by the Training Center and Operations

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management personnel to determine if such individuals can or cannot assume shift duties. This evaluation will include the results of EOP-specific demonstrations, as felt necessary on a case-by-case assessment.

It is to be noted that the two individuals most-recently promoted to the shift supervisor position are scheduled to receive the above training during this current week and next week.
