Lost Creek ISR, LLC, hereby requests that these submittals be considered as fulfilling requirements of license conditions 9.7 (specifying health physics designee qualifications) and 12.13 (providing for NRC review and approval a revised decommissioning, decontamination and reclamation plan within 90 days of receipt of license)). However, regarding the November 16, submission, Lost Creek ISR, LLC, commits to maintaining its on-site meteorological station indefinitely, at least, until collected data is determined by NRC to be representative of long-term conditions.
