Dear Ms. Johnson:

Your letter dated October 1, 1974, requested our approval to transfer the public document room types of records for the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant and Units 1 and 2 of the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant from the Environmental Library of Minnesota (ELM) at the above address to The Environmental Conservation Library of the Minneapolis Public Library at 300 Nicollet Mall. Since the new location is as accessible to the general public, or perhaps more accessible, than the current location and appears to be of a more permanent status, we do not object to the new location.

It is requested that the records for the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant be transferred not later than November 4, 1974, because of the public hearing related to conversion of the provisional operating license for this plant to a full-term operating license currently scheduled to start on November 6, and because we understand that ELM is not open on a regular basis. In a telephone conversation between you and Mrs. Diggs of this office on October 21, 1974, you advised that the move could be accomplished in a day and without delay after our approval is given.
