PURPOSE: On October 20, 2011, a 10 CFR 2.206 petition was submitted to the
Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) requesting that the NRC
suspend the operating license of Virginia Electric Power Company
(VEPCO) for operation of NAPS and suspend restart of NAPS pending
emergency enforcement actions (Agencywide Documents Access and
Management System Accession No. ML11293A116). The purpose of
this meeting is to provide the petitioner with an additional opportunity to
address the NRC Petition Review Board (PRB) with additional
information in accordance with 10 CFR 2.206.
