We completed our review of your application to amend Special Nuclear Materials License SNM-124, transmitted by letter dated August 5, 2011. Our review of your application has identified that additional information is needed before final action can be taken on your submittal.

The additional information, specified in the enclosure, should be provided within 30 days from the date of this letter.

Pending the additional information, which answers the request for additional information, we anticipate completing our review by the end of March 2012. This date could change depending on the findings of our technical review, urgent assignments, or other factors. We will promptly communicate any significant changes to this schedule.
