Enclosed is Amendment No. 08 renewing your NRC Material License No. 21-26714-01 in accordance with your request. Note that the major changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that this amendment renews your license for a ten year period and your license will not expire until January 31, 2022.

Please note that we modified your license by updating Condition No. 8.A, as it appeared on Amendment No. 07. The total possession limit was increased as requested in your application dated July 6, 2011.

We also modified your license by updating Subitem No. 9.A. The manufacturers' "Betacontrol" was corrected with the complete name "Betacontrol of America."

In addition, we added Michael Matthews as your Alternate RSO; we updated Condition Nos. 13 and 15; and we added Condition Nos. 23, 24, and 25. These changes have affected the numbering of your license conditions so please review your renewed license carefully.

These changes consisted of reformatting your license to include several standard license conditions that appeared to be missing from your license. Placing them on your license now should enhance your awareness of the radiation safety program elements in your license and our regulatory requirements.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
