If time allows, we would also like to discuss RAI-241 (6173) question 09.02.05-17. The question concerns the impact if the wet bulb temperature exceeds the value used to confirm the CPNPP UHS design. Per the RG (1.27), the meteorological values used to confirm the design are bounding values and neither regulatory guidance nor precedent requires assessment or analyses of conditions that exceed the bounding values. We are preparing a response and would like to confirm that we understand the question fully.
