Waiver_Purpose: C-10 Foundation is a 501c3 research and education foundation who informs the public at public meetings and forums on any public safety or health concern pertaining to Seabrook Station's operation.

The C-10 Foundation has had an overwhelming number of requests to be inform on the ASR concrete degradation at Seabrook and seeks these records to prepare accurate information for public meetings.
