On 1/17/2012 the Buckhannon location of use was inspected. The arrangement that TTG has with the client site (St. Joseph's Hospital) is that RAM is delivered by TTG to a locked, storage cabinet that is located on the hospital's loading dock. The NMT, a TTG employee, pick-ups the RAM and transports it to an office inside the hospital for use. At the end of the day, the NMT transports any unused dosages and the waste to the locked storage cabinet for decay. TTG has operated the hospital as a client site and the storage cabinet was considered the base site. This facility has been operated in this way, under an agreement with the hospital, since 2006. The St. Joe's address was added to the TTG license because the medical insurance carrier (Highmark Blue Cross and Blue Shield) would not pay the physicians if the location was not listed on the NRC license.

Since 2006, operations at this client site have increased significantly. Initially TTG sent a NMT to the site from Pittsburgh 1-2 days per week. Now there is a permanent camera and TTG employee stationed at the site. She performs tests Monday through Friday. In the interest of security of the RAM, I discussed the possibility of TTG entering into an agreement with the hospital so that the RAM could be delivered to the office inside the hospital. The agreement would need to state that TTG has complete control over the area. D. Ashton stated that TTG is currently negotiating their contract with St. Joseph's Hospital and he believed he could make this arrangement with the hospital.
