Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.336, the agreement among the parties dated September 10, 2009, and the Initial Scheduling Order dated October 20, 2009, Nuclear Innovation North America LLC (NINA) is providing the twenty-eighth update to its disclosures with respect to Intervenor's Contention FC-1, as admitted by the Board on September 30, 2011 (LBP-11-25).

a copy, NINA will work with the Intervenor to develop a mutually acceptable proposed amendment to the Protective Order for issuance by the Board. NINA will provide any requested proprietary documents to the Intervenor after the Board has entered an amended Protective Order.
