NRC Request for Additional Information (RAI) 317 (Reference 1) addresses Physical Security Hardware – Inspections, Tests, Analyses, and Acceptance Criteria, as discussed in Appendix B Section 2.2 of the Inspections, Tests, Analyses, and Acceptance Criteria (ITAAC) and ITAAC Closure, as submitted in Part 10 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 7.

Our Updated RAI Closure Plan (Reference 2), submitted on November 30, 2011, stated that the response to RAI No. 317 Question 14.03.12-8 would be provided by January 31, 2012. UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize the response to RAI 317, Question 14.03.12-8. A response to this question will be provided to the NRC by March 30, 2012.


