**Subject:** Questions Concerning Decommissioning Survey for Middletown, CT facility

2/2/2012 (14:45) I spoke with Mr. Soucy and Mr. Alberghini about the licensee's request to have the facilities in Middletown, CT be released for unrestricted use. They had questions on how to proceed since the building where licensed activities had taken place was demolished some time ago and the footpad was all that remained. I responded that they should get together with their consultant and examine the data provided to see if it met the current release requirements. If any of the values do not, those areas would need to be resurveyed and a determination be made if remediation is in order. Remediation would continue until the survey values meet decommissioning criteria. The history should include when the building was demolished and the rubble removed from the area. Mr. Alberghini requested that the NRC review the Decommissioning documentation prior to it being finalized. I replied that it would be treated as an official document and the NRC staff would make comments as towards its acceptability. I informed them that there was precedent for holding the licensee to the newer standard as many old AEC sites that used source and special nuclear material were released for unrestricted use many years ago but had to be resurveyed using the newer limits. Both individuals stated that they understood and would work with their consultant to see what needed to be done.
