During a phone conversation on January 25, 2012, with Kevin Ramsey, NFS requested an extension of the due date to respond to Requests for Additional Information (RAIs) regarding the FSS Report Surface Soil Characterization, Survey Units 1 and 2 (TAC L33175). NFS needed the additional time to coordinate the Survey Units 1 and 2 responses with those for open questions on the FSS for Survey Units 2, 8, 9, 19, and 20 (TAC L32997). NFS requested an extension to March 2, 2012, for both licensing activities.
