I contacted Dr. Kolodziej to check his progress on obtaining a FA instrument. We are highly unlikely to get any FA instrument by Friday.

Dr. Kolodziej said he has been unable to get any of the local insurance companies to issue him a bond for the amount required for decommissioning of the cyclotron. He said that the companies are very uneasy (one agent told him that he was concerned the cyclotron would blow up and the insurance would have to pay for it.) I asked him if he had gone to any bank directly to obtain a bond, and he said that he usually obtains bonds through insurance companies.

He again offered to put up properties that he owns (townhouses); I told him that property is not an approved FA instrument. He said that tomorrow, he is taking an insurance agent to see some properties that he owns, to see if the insurance company will accept them as the basis for a bond. He said that he was about to call me to request a week's extension. I told him that I could not grant an extension, because this issue is being handled at a higher management level. I told him that I would raise his request, but that it would be unlikely to be granted. In the meantime, I told him to continue pursuing a FA instrument because if (when) he has to stop work after Friday, he will not be allowed to re-start until an FA instrument is in place.

He mentioned having a potential buyer for the cyclotron. He mentioned how important the cyclotron is to his medical business. He mentioned that the Lantheus cyclotron was down the past two days and medical facilities were coming to Int'l cyclotron for product (although he did not say if he was able to provide product.) He also told me that he purchased an automatic dispenser for his product from an Illinois? Indiana? company that he visited recently because he wants to stay in business and improve his process.

I asked him if he got the January 31 letter, and told him that a copy was hand-delivered to the cyclotron facility last week. He said he did not receive the January 31 letter, or he does not recall receiving it.

He emphasized several times at how surprised he is that he cannot get a bond through an insurance

company, that he thought it would be easy...he was on the phone until 10 pm last night with an insurance agent...etc.

I also told him that I was contacted by our Fees office because they have not received payment for his annual fee and have been unable to reach him. He asked for the name and phone number of the contact there, so I gave him Mona Williams name and telephone number. He said he would call her immediately.
