Condition 12 of the license specifies that the Radiation Safety Officer is Kimberly A. Bennett.

The Radiation Safety Officer named on the license (Kimberly A. Bennett) left the licensee in June 2011, and as of January 18, 2012, the licensee had not requested an amendment to its license to designate a new Radiation Safety Officer. This is a violation of Condition 12 of the license.

The licensee corrected this violation by providing a letter dated January 18, 2012, to the inspector requesting to change the radiation safety officer on the license.

Statement of Corrective Actions

I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, date when full compliance will be achieved).
