Dear Dr. Rakowski:

We received a letter dated November 21, 2011, signed by Mara Jelich requesting Abhirami Hallock, M.D. to be added to your license as an authorized user for the Gamma Knife.

The information provided regarding Dr. Hallock's training and experience is not sufficient to add him as an authorized user for the Gamma Knife on your license. Specifically, item 3.d. of the NRC Form 313A(AUS) does not specify the number of total hours of experience (see 10 CFR 35.690(b)(1)(ii)). A Dr. T. Sexton who is listed as supervising individual in item 3.d of the NRC form appears to be from Canada, therefore it seems unlikely that Dr. Sexton supervised Dr. Hallock's work experience at Karmanos Cancer Center.

Based on the above, this request has been voided without prejudice. If you wish to pursue this matter in the future, please provide the following with your amendment request:

1. A **completed** current 313A(AUS) form which can be obtained from the nrc.gov home page under Forms. Also review 10 CFR 35.690 (b) and (c) for the information needed to complete the 313A(AUS) form.
2. A copy of Dr. Hallock's medical school diploma.
3. A copy of Dr. Hallock's State of Michigan registry.
4. A complete package with your request. Do not rely on previously sent material send everything needed to support your request to add Dr. Hallock as an authorized user.
5. Information on all "supervising individuals" named on the 313A(AUS) form showing that they are Gamma Knife authorized users in accordance with 10 CFR 35.690.


Please provide a copy of any Board certifications, recognized by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, which Dr. Hallock may have.
