We have reviewed your renewal application dated August 25, 2011 for NRC License No. 21-20166-01. Before we can take further action, we will need additional information. Please confirm with the followings.

1. The total quantities of licensed material will remain the same as authorized on the NRC License No. 21-20166-01 Amendment No. 11.
2. Licensed material may be used at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States where the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material.
