This letter is a request to amend our material license # 40-29306-02.

We are requesting a change of Radiation Safety Officer from Nastassia Alavi to Eric Fuehrer. Also, we would like to remove Nastassia Alavi as an authorized user on the license.

Our Radiation Safety Officer, Nastassia Alavi, has resigned and has taken a position in another state; therefore, we will need to have a new RSO. Eric Fuehrer has been an authorized user and is our primary chemist for radiological testing. Eric received a B.S. in metallurgical engineering in 1995 and has a current PE license. He is scheduled to attend RSO training in February 2012.

This will place us without a radiation Safety Officer until Eric's status is approved. We believe this will not add any risk to our radiation safety during this brief time due to the following: 1) We are still proceeding slowly with our implementation of radiological testing of drinking water and have not yet tested any samples requiring certification. 2) Patricia Tibbetts, our former RSO, is still employed here and is available for consultation. 3) The levels of radiation in the practice drinking water samples and our calibration standards are very low.
