3/28/2012 (14:50) I spoke with Mr. Brown about the 2012 self-assessment of financial assurance documents and that the self-assessment identified that a Certification of Financial Assurance (CFA) had not been submitted with the Statement of Intent during the previous licensing action. I helped Mr. Brown navigate the NRC website so that he could download a model copy of the CFA for his use. After examining the document, Mr. Brown asked what added benefit there was for completing the document. I replied that for a licensee using a Statement of Intent, it has less use but that the CFA was useful for keeping the license reviewer and the licensee aware of what items trigger financial assurance and any changes to the license need to be considered which may affect the amount of financial assurance that would be required to decommission the license. Mr. Brown stated that it would take a bit of time to acquire the proper signatures after the document is completed. I stated that it was alright if it took some time and that I would issue a "reminder letter" as a request for information in three weeks.
