For FOIA 2011-0366, the Seabrook ASR TIA letter dated 9/12/2011, Chuck Mullins, OGC does not concur on the FOIA package. The comments:

1. If some information is preliminary, it can be so stated in the release cover letter.
2. The harm statement is not valid.

Absent an alternative harm statement acceptable to OGC, the full TIA letter release to the requester will initiate on Friday, 11/4/2011.

As the purpose of the TIA is to define what RI sees as needed work by NRR prior to deciding the next steps in the resolution of the ASR problem, the information is not pre-decisional.

My proposal is to have the full letter sent to the requester. M Modes concurs with this action.
